## **RABBIT RIDGE AREA REPAVING PROJECT: JUNE 10-28, 2019**

**KESHENA, Wis.** – Menominee County and the Town of Menominee has contracted with Northeast Asphalt, Inc. to re-pave and re-shoulder Rabbit Ridge Road and Rabbit Ridge Court. Northeast Asphalt, Inc. will begin construction on June 10<sup>th</sup> and complete all work by June 28<sup>th</sup>. Construction phases, in summary, consist of the following: (1) traffic signs will be erected on June 10<sup>th</sup>; (2) road pulverizing will begin on June 12<sup>th</sup> through the 14<sup>th</sup>; (3) paving operations will begin on June 17<sup>th</sup> through the 19<sup>th</sup>; and (5) shouldering will take place one week later. Rain may impact the schedule.

Roads will be closed to all thru traffic, except for local residents, public transit, and emergency vehicles. Though public transit will be able to operate within the area as needed, larger transit buses could pose a problem during paving operations, especially for uncured pavement. Local residents will not be able to park on the shoulders or roadways between the hours of 6:00 a.m. and 7:00 p.m. during all phases of construction. Flaggers will be present to help local residents navigate active areas of the work zone. Thru traffic commuters normally using Rabbit Ridge Road to access Old South Branch Road and STH 47 are urged to go around on CTH VV-East.
