Shawano-Menominee Counties Health Department has been working with any individuals who test positive to assure isolation and quarantine are followed for these individuals and their close contacts. Also, Shawano-Menominee Counties Health Department is working with any businesses that are impacted by COVID-19 to make sure precautions are taken to protect other employees and the community.

As cases continue to increase in our community, we continue to remind everyone to follow any guidelines and recommendations that are set in place to help protect yourselves and your businesses during this pandemic challenge. Each person should continue to monitor for COVID-19 [symptoms](#).
