

MARRIAGE LICENSE

Both parties need to be present when applying for a marriage license.
The marriage license process takes approximately 20-30 minutes to complete.

Required documents:

Residency requirement- Provide proof of residence. At least one of the applicants must be a resident of the State of Wisconsin. Exceptions are made to persons coming from out of State to get married in Wisconsin. Both applicants must provide proof of residence. Acceptable documents may include a Wisconsin photo ID, Drivers License, Utility bill, bank statement or a lease agreement. ** All documents must have your current physical residence on them.*

ID requirements- You must bring a valid Drivers License, State ID or a Tribal ID with your current address or two pieces of current mail with your current address. You will need to know your Social Security Number, and provide a Certified Copy of your birth certificate. ** NO COPIED Birth certificates will be accepted.*

Documentation of prior marriages

If either applicant was married in the past, the applicant will need to provide documentation of a finalized divorce decree or death certificate.

Officiant Information

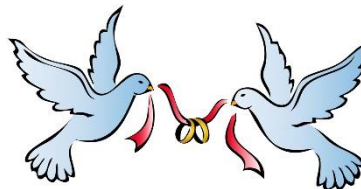
Applicants will need to provide the name, address and phone number of the person who is performing the ceremony.

****The date of marriage and the officiant information needs to be decided prior to applying for a marriage license.***

****Cost of your marriage license is \$55.00, acceptable forms of payment are cash, check, debt/credit card.***

****The State of Wisconsin has a mandatory 3 day waiting period. This does not include the day of application.***
