ZONING ORDINANCE

The Board of Supervisors for the County of Menominee does ordain as follows:

- **1. Amendment.** Sec. 8.517 of the Zoning Ordinance is amended by adding the following new subsection under Par. A:
 - '5. That the date for permitting seasonal camping shall be postponed and delayed during any period when MC has declared public health emergency and it shall be deemed a violation of this section to engage in seasonal camping while such a declaration of a public health emergency is in effect."
- **2. Effective Date.** This amendment shall become effective immediately upon passage by the Menominee County Board of Supervisors.

In order to comply with Social Distancing and gathering of groups of no more than 10 a maximum of 10 persons are permitted in the Board room at one time and must maintain the 6 foot social distancing at all times.
