

WHAT TO EXPECT WHEN COMING TO THE POLLS NOVEMBER 3 masks are required

VOTING PROCEDURE

- 1. YOU WILL ENTER THE POLLING PLACE. make sure you have your ID**
- 2. SANITIZE YOUR HANDS. The greeter will have a sanitizing spray and spray your hands for you**
- 3. HAVE YOUR TEMPATURE TAKEN. there will be a kiosk**
- 4. PROCEED there will be a path marked out with cones for social distancing.**
- 5. ONCE YOU GET TO THE CHECK-IN TABLE:**

HAVE YOUR ID READY. THE POLL WORKER WILL ASK YOU YOUR NAME AND ADDRESS. It is hard to hear with masks on, so please place your ID against the plexiglass so the poll worker can see your name and address also.

THIS PROCESS IS TO MAKE SURE YOU ARE REGISTERED. If you know you need to register, let the greeter know. YOU WILL NEED TO PROVIDE PROOF OF RESIDENCE. If you are not sure if you need to register, call the Clerk's office 715-799-3311 or you can check on myvote.wi.gov

If you get to the check-in table and need to register you will be directed to the registration table.

Once the check-in is complete you will receive your voter number and will be directed to the right pollbook table. keep your ID ready

6. ARRIVE AT YOUR POLL BOOK TABLE. You will be asked to state your name and address for the record. Hand the voter number to the poll worker, they will find you in the pollbook and have you sign the first book. Then you will proceed to the Ballot table.

7. BALLOT TABLE you will receive your ballot and be directed to the nearest open poll booth.

8. POLL BOOTH fill out your ballot. Fill in the oval for the candidate that you are choosing.

9. VOTING MACHINE deposit your ballot in the voting machine and exit.
