Meeting Minutes

Public Hearing

1. *Call to order and roll call.* Misty W. calls the meeting to Order at 4:00 p.m. Committee members present: Liz Arnold, Beth Moses and Misty Wayka. Also present are Zoning Administrator Jeremy Johnson, Chad DeBauch, Scott Whitman and Lori Whitman.
2. Conditional use permit request for W2267 Joe Summers Road. Mr. DeBauch describes his request and there are a few questions by committee members.
3. Conditional use permit requests for N684 Southeast Bass Lake Road. Mr. and Mrs. Whitman describe their two requests and there a few questions by committee members.

3. *Conditional use permit request for W2267 Joe Summers Road.* Beth motions to approve the permit request with the condition that the owner follows the same camping guidelines as Legend Lake seasonal campers have in place, Liz seconds the motion. All in favor, motion passes.
4. *Conditional use permit requests for N684 Southeast Bass Lake Road.* Liz motions to approve the permit request for the privacy fence along the property line and that it shall conform to the guidelines in the zoning ordinance, Beth seconds the motion. All in favor, motion passes. Liz motions to approve the second permit request for the steel tubular fence for temporary boarding of horses overnight, Beth seconds the motion. All in favor, motion passes.
5. *Zoning Ordinance amendment for raising chickens.* Jeremy describes the language he drafted for the meeting. It was mostly taken from the Oneida County Zoning Ordinance. There has been interest by many community members to raise chickens for meat and eggs. Beth motions to send this item and language to the County Board for their consideration, Liz seconds the motion. All in favor, motion passes.
6. *Zoning Ordinance amendment for vacation home rentals.* Jeremy describes the language and the request by some residents. After some discussion on the potential ordinance language, the committee decides not to take any action at this time. This may be revisited at a later date.
