Meeting Minutes

Public Hearing

1. *Call to order and roll call.* Misty W. calls the meeting to Order at 4:03 p.m. Committee members present: Liz Fernandez, Beth Moses and Misty Wayka. Also present are Zoning Administrator Jeremy Johnson and possibly members of the public on the phone call. The audio was not understandable when it was asked who else was on the call.
2. *Proposed amendment to the Zoning Ordinance, Section 33.* Jeremy J. describes the proposed language to be added to Section 33. Liz F. asks two questions of clarification. No other questions or comments are received.
3. Adjourn public hearing at 4:09 p.m.

Business Portion

1. *Approval of meeting minutes from May 11, 2020.* Beth motions to approve minutes as presented, Liz seconds. All in favor, motion passes.
2. *Zoning Ordinance Section 33, proposed amendment for raising chickens and ducks.* Liz motions to recommend adoption by the county board, Beth seconds the motion. All in favor, motion passes.
3. *Department update.* Jeremy J. describes how the department has been working with COVID-19 protocols and being safe. Permit numbers are higher than usual as many people are doing projects.

Jeremy describes the notice he received from the Community Development Department of the Tribe. He states that he isn't sure how to proceed with any notice or enforcement of these dilapidated properties and old homes. There is an old Town Ordinance (No. 17) from the 1960s that may be applicable for this type of property. Sections 8, 9, and 12 specifically address the issues at hand. Some research needs to be done to determine the applicability of the Ordinance and how to get these properties cleaned up. Jeremy will start with Ruth Winter in the Land Information Office to determine which properties are owned by the county or tribe versus being owned privately.

4. *Next meeting time and agenda items.* The agenda will have Town Ordinance 17 and property complaints on the agenda.
